- **Technology Transfer Opportunity Mechanism**
 - TTOM Awards are to encourage then enable Scottish SMEs to transfer technology from Scotland's Universities
- **The TTOM Awards fund feasibility studies allowing SMEs to access expertise in Scottish universities**
 - Grants of up to £5000 are available to tackle problems relevant to the SME
- **The aim is to enable technology transfer projects, particularly with a cross-sectoral and inter-disciplinary focus**
 - The SME is expected to make a contribution to the project, which can be in-kind
 - Application examples: Imaging, semiconductors, sensors and software
 - Market examples: Energy, Life Sciences, Digital Media, Enabling Technologies, Sustainable Transport
